Hatching Chicks with Children. Over the course of 21 days, the children were able to observe the eggs in the incubator. They also participated in “candling” experiments, which allowed them to take a peek at the chicks’ progress inside the eggs. Each of the classroom teachers incorporated some learning activities related to chicks during the month,...Resource > Eggs, hatching, chickens - Incubation and embryology: Kindergarten to Grade 3 Suggestions, lesson plans, on how to use classroom incubation and embryonic development projects to enhance programs in science, language arts, mathematics, social studies, and art. A hen lays an average of 300 eggs per year. When a hen is "broody," it means she wants to hatch her eggs. The hen will sit on her eggs to keep them warm so that they will hatch into chicks. A fertilized egg starts developing into a chicken when its temperature reaches 86 degrees fahrenheit. A chicken takes 21 days to hatch.
